OTAGO ANNIVERSARY DAY

The dance school will be closed on **Monday 24 March** to observe Otago Anniversary Day.

SCHOOL HOLIDAYS

The dance school will close for the School Holidays on Sunday 13 April and reopen on Monday 28 April.

TERM 2 ENROLMENTS

You do not need to re-enrol your child each term, but I would appreciate you letting me know if they are not returning for the next term as I do have waiting lists for some classes and this would ensure that these new students can start at the beginning of the term rather than having to wait until several weeks into the term when I work out who has not returned.

DANCE SCHOOL UNIFORM & HAIR

An important part of dance is how you present yourself. If you present yourself in an untidy manner then your dancing will tend to be untidy, but if you are well presented and prepared for the dance class, then you will work better and the teacher will be able to see your posture more easily and, therefore, be better able to give corrections. On colder days, we would prefer students wear polyprops instead of baggy sweatshirts or jerseys so they are able to move more freely and teachers can see their body positions and movements.

Hair should be off the face - in a bun for Ballet and tied in a pony tail for Jazz, Tap, Musical Theatre, and Contemporary. If hair is short, it needs to be pinned back off the face with bobby pins or a cloth headband (not a plastic one as these tend to fly off while dancing).

All students are asked to be dressed neatly and appropriately as per the uniform requirements outlined in the Bennett School of Ballet & Jazz Handbook.

FEES

As the dance school is a small business, we require fees to be paid within 2 weeks of receipt of your invoice to ensure the successful running of the school. Please make sure that any outstanding Term 1 fees are paid as soon as possible.
